



COVID Plan - Parent Volunteers

Parent volunteers are an important part of day to day life at Waverley, we are always grateful for the help and assistance they provide to many areas of the school. During the current global pandemic it is important that both the school and parents are made aware of the safeguards that are in place and the requirements that need to be adhered to when volunteering at Waverley.

COVID provisions:

- Volunteers will have access to hand sanitiser
- Volunteers who are working in either the Junior or Senior canteens will need to wear a face mask. Volunteers in other areas will be provided masks if they wish.
- Volunteers should observe basic, regular hand hygiene
- Volunteers should observe 1.5m social distancing where possible

In the following scenarios parents should not volunteer or if they have previously agreed to volunteer they should not attend either Campus.

- If you have travelled overseas in the last 14 days
- If you have been in contact with a possible COVID-19 case where results are unknown
- If you are exhibiting unexplained fever, respiratory symptoms or flu like symptoms
- If you have recently (within the last 14 days) visited any parts of Australia deemed to be high risk by the NSW Department of Health

If during the time you volunteer at Waverley you come into contact with a positive COVID-19 case you should stay away from school and notify the School as soon as possible.
