You can apply for undergraduate courses, the Educational Access Scheme, Schools Recommendation Scheme, and Equity Scholarships.

UAC has emailed all students a UAC PIN, which is used along with your NESAs number to login and access UAC's services. All semester 1, 2022 courses will be available from **August**.

Early bird applications will close at midnight on **Thursday 30 September**.

- If your Year 11 results don't meet entry requirements, we will automatically consider your Year 12 results in the December offer round
- There is no application fee
- You will be required to meet the co-curricular or service requirement - we have adjusted our requirements due to the disruptions of COVID-19, please review the updated co-curricular or service schedule
- You will apply for admission, guaranteed accommodation, and over 200 scholarships all in one application

### **University of Sydney Mathematics Prerequisites**

The University has [mathematics course prerequisites](#) for some courses. This means that to study certain degrees, students will need to achieve a Band 4 in the NSW Higher School Certificate (HSC) Mathematics (not general mathematics) or [equivalent](#).

- If students don't meet the mathematics requirements, they may be able to:
- complete the [Mathematics MOOC](#) (Massive Open Online Course) and exam
- apply for another course and then transfer into their preferred course in their second year (after successful completion of an accepted 1000 level mathematics unit).
